ROTARY WHEELS AT WILLOW SPRINGS - THE RACE TO END POLIO



On April 7, 2012 the Lancaster West Rotary Club is conducting a major event at Willow Springs International Raceway that we project to be the biggest END POLIO NOW fundraiser in the United States this year. The event is being supported by Rotary clubs throughout southern California and marketed to individuals who enjoy motorsports and high performance cars and have the financial ability to indulge in these pursuits while supporting an important cause.

Why are we doing this? After 20 years of hard work, Rotary and its partners are on the brink of eradicating this tenacious disease. Your sponsorship will directly support immunization campaigns in developing countries, where polio continues to infect and paralyze children, robbing them of their futures and compounding the hardships faced by their families.

Willow Springs International Raceway is located in Willow Springs near Rosamond and Lancaster, California, and is about an hour north of Los Angeles. This motorsports park is a 600 acre complex of eight racetracks hosting nearly every conceivable motor sports discipline.

What will the day be like? There are three motorsports activities available for participants to choose from at Rotary Wheels at Willow Springs:

(1) LAPPING BIG WILLOW

The main track (Big Willow) is a challenging 2.5-mile road course patterned after the great road racing courses of Europe. The elevation changes and high average speeds make it a favorite of many road racing drivers. Michael Andretti has the track record of 1:06 in an Indy Car, with Nigel Mansell a fraction of a second slower in a Formula One car.

Our Lapping Big Willow event allows drivers of all ability levels to come out and do laps on this great track. Participants will be grouped by experience level. Experienced racers, novices and everyone in between will be placed in appropriate sessions.

(2) DRIFTING EXHIBITION

Drifting is a driving technique and motorsport where the driver intentionally over steers, causing loss of traction and skidding the rear wheels through turns. The spectacle of smoke

billowing from tires while the driver maintains vehicle control and a high exit speed has made drifting a popular motorsport worldwide.

We will have one of the top Drift clubs in the country on hand demonstrating their skills. Best of all, participants will be able to ride along as the drift cars slide around the specially designed course.

(3) KARTING EXPERIENCE

Karting is considered the first step in any serious racer's career. It has become the stepping stone to the higher and more expensive ranks of motorsports. Drivers will be placed in the appropriate group based on experience, given a briefing and explanation of the karts and will get lots of seat time.

In addition to the three motorsports activities, we will have a steak dinner for drivers and other attendees. There is also a vendor area catering to the select clientele we expect at this event.
